2. Matters arising from previous minutes

Councillor Ellen Harvey shared information regarding the planters placed outside Talacre community centre. Clerk Lydia Harvey shared an email received from Nigel Seaburg explaining that the community council will cover the planters on our insurance and any maintenance will be carried out by the volunteers.

Chairman Sian Braun requested an update on the local police attending a meeting. Clerk Lydia Harvey informed all councillors that Police officer Mathew Griffiths will be attending the next meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> of May. Councillors have been informed to share any question they have in advance.

Councillor Dave Brown asked for an update on Holywell Leisure centre. Clerk Lydia Harvey has made the agreed donation.

Chairman Sian Braun and County Councillor Gina Maddison gave updates on the wall outside Gronant institute. Flintshire County Council have been to view it and confirmed the owner must complete the repairs and work with the conservation officer when doing so.

Councillor Elena Charlton-Fleming shared an update on behalf of County Councillor Glyn Banks regarding the Picton Cemetery benches, there is a sponsor available. County Councillor Glyn Banks will inform the individual to contact the council to do this. Councillor Mike Williams will be going to Picton Cemetery to make repairs on the benches.
