1. Guest Speaker – Phil Beal & Derek Williams Ffynnongroyw & Penyffordd War memorial committee

Phil & Derek attended the meeting to discuss the war memorial at Picton Cemetery. They would like to have a footpath installed on the grass leading up to the memorial.

They are working to renovate Ffynnongroyw war memorial with its original stone and re-engraving and correcting the names to preserve the memorial. The council were presented with possible designs that are being considered for the war memorial.

Dog fouling neighbourhood watch for ongoing issues in the area.

Road works on Llanasa Road between its junctions with Kelston Farm School House Junction and Nant-y-Crai Lane for an approximate distance of 1117 metres for re-surfacing are due to begin on 23rd February for 12 days.

Recycling session was attended by Michele Shaw, this was successful and all recycling supplies were taken by residents.

Ms. Sullivan from Ysgol Gronant approached Gina about starting a lunch club, as it's been successful at Ysgol Bryn Garth.

Red Lion in Llanasa is hoping to open by easter/may bank holiday.

County Councillor Glyn Banks – Ffynngroyw Police House appeal has not been successful.

Recycling connect centre is going on the road and will be coming to Talacre.
