4. County Councillor Glyn Banks reported that he is seeking to establish an Andy's Man Club in Trelogan. He is undertaking a litter-picking challenge to raise funds for this initiative and for Macmillan Cancer Support. The programme commenced on Saturday, 21 March in Mostyn, and will continue in Trelogan, Gronant, Penyffordd and Ffynnongroyw. An Easter-themed litter pick is scheduled to take place on 4 April.
