The meeting began with a welcoming for Joanne Gillmore, new community councillor for the Gronant area.

2. Minutes were confirmed by Councillor Ellen Harvey and seconded by Councillor Mike Williams.

3. Chairman Sian Braun asked for an update on the website. Clerk Lydia Harvey informed the council that a meeting has been organised for Friday 3rd of November.

Councillor Dave Brown informed the council that the bench that was discussed in the last meeting will not be going ahead as street scene have said it is too close to the highway.

Chairman Sian Braun handed out certificates for defibrillator training that took place in September 2023. Chairman Sian Braun expressed her disappointment in the poor attendance of the training from the community councillors.

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6. Gronant Skate Park – Chairman Sian Braun took the proposed plans for Gronant Skate Park to the local school where they were presented to the children, the feedback confirmed that the children would like to keep the skate park. 7. Streetlight replacement Trelogan – There has been no change to the light situation.

ONGOING – Clerk Lydia Harvey will email Nigel from street scene to ask for updates.

8. Moel View Road lighting – Clerk Lydia Harvey read out a response from Darrell Jones and Sarah Samuel FCC. They recommended option 1 of MEGA quote and that FCC can adopt the lights at an additional cost.

ONGOING - Clerk Lydia Harvey will invite Darrel Jones to the next meeting.

9. County Councillor Glyn Banks, has asked for planning applications and agenda's to be uploaded on Facebook. It was agreed for this to be done going forward. Councillors agreed for links to FCC planning website to be shared on Facebook.

RESOLVED – Clerk Lydia Harvey will complete these actions going forward.

10. Clerk Pension – Clerk Lydia Harvey and Councillor Ellen Harvey were asked to leave the room, while it was discussed.

ONGOING - Councillors agreed a contribution amount.

11. Numbering streetlights, Clerk Lydia Harvey has informed the council that Lucie from MEGA provided a spreadsheet with 364 lights asking for them to be checked and approved for numbering.

ONGOING – Clerk Lydia Harvey has asked for volunteers to join a separate meeting for the purpose of checking the spreadsheet and cross referencing them with the maps. Councillors Dave Brown, Mike Williams and Glyn Banks have volunteered.

12. Submit Payments – All councillors approved unanimously.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS

1. Arfon Williams-Cooke has informed Clerk Lydia Harvey that extra work is required at Picton cemetery for maintenance during November/December. He will be removing ivy from the shed and gate posts, the pathway towards the tap needs tidying and digging out around the edges and he needs to buy some topsoil as some of the graves are sinking. He wants to have all this work done in time for Christmas, so the cemetery is looking tidy, he has estimated the costs to be around £350.

ONGOING – Councillor Mike Williams will look at the Bench to see if it can be made safe. If not ask Arfon to replace it all costs covered, all councillors agreed unanimously.

2. Councillor Jenny Roberts has asked County Councillor Glyn Banks if he knows what the protocol is when allocations are made for a house in Flintshire. It was explained that houses are given to based on applications and circumstances put forward to the council.

3. Councillor Dave Brown asked for an update on the local police attending the council meetings as it has been 2 years since the last attendance.

ONGOING – Clerk Lydia Harvey has contacted the local police team, awaiting a response.

4. Minning monument – County Councillor Glyn Banks would like to ask for financial aid to support a planning application. Councillors have agreed to pay 50% of the planning application fee and to adopt the monument for insurance purposes once it's in place.

RESOLVED - All councillors have agreed unanimously.

5. Councillor Ellen Harvey has asked about the responsibility of the hedges on entrance into Talacre as they are overgrown and causing issues for pedestrians.

ONGOING – Clerk Lydia Harvey will email street scene to ask about the responsibility.

6. County Councillor Glyn Banks has asked Clerk Lydia Harvey to send letter to Talacre beach asking them to complete maintenance on the fences.

ONGOING – Councillor Ellen Harvey is going to send photo evidence to Clerk Lydia Harvey to be included in the letter.
